Dear Mr. Langdon:

On November 21, 2018, the Federal Election Commission notified your client, MeToo Ohio and Lisa Lisker in her official capacity as treasurer, of a complaint alleging that your client had violated certain sections of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended.

On May 20, 2021, the Commission considered the complaint but there was an insufficient number of votes to find reason to believe that your client violated the Act. Accordingly, on August 12, 2021, the Commission closed its file in this matter.

Documents related to the case will be placed on the public record within 30 days. *See* Disclosure of Certain Documents in Enforcement and Other Matters, 81 Fed. Reg. 50,702 (Aug. 2, 2016), effective September 1, 2016. A Statement of Reasons explaining the Commission's decision will follow.
