This is in reference to the complaint you filed with the Federal Election Commission on November 18, 2018, concerning Jefferson United, Inc. Based on that complaint, on April 28, 2021, the Commission found that there was reason to believe Jefferson United, Inc., violated 52 U.S.C. §§ 30120(a) and 30104(b) or (c), and (g), provisions of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended, and instituted an investigation of this matter. However, after considering the circumstances of this matter, the Commission determined to take no further action as to Jefferson United, Inc., and closed the file in this matter on January 25, 2024.

Documents related to the case will be placed on the public record within 30 days. *See* Disclosure of Certain Documents in Enforcement and Other Matters, 81 Fed. Reg. 50,702 (Aug. 2, 2016).

The Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended, allows a complainant to seek judicial review of the Commission's dismissal of this action. *See* 52 U.S.C. § 30109(a)(8). If you have any questions, please contact me at (202) 694-1650.
