The Federal Election Commission (“Commission”) has considered your complaint dated November 26, 2018 and determined to dismiss the allegations that the respondents violated the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended (the “Act”). Accordingly, on April 8, 2021, the Commission closed its file in this matter. A Statement of Reasons providing a basis for the Commission’s decision will follow.
