On February 1, 2019, and July 11, 2019, respectively, the Federal Election Commission (“Commission”) notified your client, National Media Research Planning & Placement LLC, d/b/a Red Eagle Media Group, and d/b/a American Media & Advocacy Group LLC, of complaints alleging violations of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended (the “Act”). A copy of each complaint was forwarded to your client at that time. On September 6, 2022, the Commission closed its files in these matters.
