Dear Mses. Tuck and Newton:

On February 25, 2019, the Federal Election Commission notified your client, Congressional Leadership Fund and Caleb Crosby in his official capacity as treasurer, of a complaint alleging violations of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended. A copy of the complaint was forwarded to your client at that time.

On July 2, 2020, the Commission found, on the basis of the information in the Complaint, and information provided by your client, that there is no reason to believe Congressional Leadership Fund and Caleb Crosby in his official capacity as treasurer violated 52 U.S.C. § 30119(a)(2). Accordingly, the Commission closed its file in this matter.

Documents related to the case will be placed on the public record within 30 days. *See* Disclosure of Certain Documents in Enforcement and Other Matters, 81 Fed. Reg. 50,702 (Aug. 2, 2016).
