On February 28, 2019, your clients, Skytron LLC and The KMW Group, Inc. were notified that the Federal Election Commission received a complaint that alleging violations of certain sections of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended. At that time your clients were given a copy of the complaint and informed that response to the complaint should be submitted within 15 days of receipt of the notification.
