On February 28, 2019, the Hawaii Republican Party and you in your official capacity as treasurer were notified that the Federal Election Commission received a complaint alleging violations of certain sections of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended. At that time you were given a copy of the complaint and informed that response to the complaint should be submitted within 15 days of receipt of the notification.


