This response is provided to address the additional complainant issues regarding MUR 7572 . The previous response remains valid and this letter supplements those facts.

After coordinating with the Chairman of the Hawaii Republican Party regarding the shredding of documents, the following information is provided.

The Hawaii Republican Party collects sensitive personal information that our members expect us to protect. Our headquarters co-owners also protect their member's personal information by shredding. We shred material as needed and when volunteers have time. It is a continual process. Shredding results in large bags of shredded materials. The Chairman remembers asking volunteers to shred about the time in question. She related to me that it was to discard very old and outdated forms and headquarters' paperwork. Shredding is a continual, normal, good management practice. I was assured that there was no attempt to conceal any misdeed.

The HRP continues to believe that the complainant's allegations are unfounded and based on an inadequate understanding of FEC regulations.
