On February 28, 2019, May 2, 2019, and May 7, 2019, the Federal Election Commission (“Commission”) notified you of a complaint and its supplements alleging violations of certain sections of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended, by the Hawaii Republican Party and Mary Smart in her official capacity as treasurer. A copy of the complaint and supplements were previously forwarded to you.

Upon further review of the allegations contained in the complaint, and information supplied by the respondents, the Commission voted to close the file this matter on October 28, 2021. The Factual and Legal Analysis or Statement(s) of Reasons, which more fully explain the Commission’s decision, will follow.
