On February 28, 2019, May 2, 2019, and May 7, 2019, the Federal Election Commission (“Commission”) notified you of a complaint and its supplements alleging violations of certain sections of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended. Upon further review of the allegations contained in the complaint, and information supplied by the respondents, the Commission voted to dismiss this matter as to you and closed the file on October 28, 2021.
