Dear Ms. Peranio:

On March 20, 2019, and May 30, 2019, the Federal Election Commission notified you of complaints alleging that you violated certain sections of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended. Copies of the complaints were forwarded to you at those times. On July 28, 2022, the Commission decided to exercise its prosecutorial discretion and to dismiss the allegations that you violated 52 U.S.C. § 30122 by permitting your name to be used to effect contributions in the name of another. The Commission has closed the files. A Statement of Reasons providing a basis for the Commission's decision will follow.

Documents related to the case will be placed on the public record within 30 days. *See* Disclosure of Certain Documents in Enforcement and Other Matters, 81 Fed. Reg. 50,702 (Aug. 2, 2016).
