Dear Ms. Gong:

On March 20, 2019, and May 30, 2019, the Federal Election Commission ("Commission") notified you of complaints alleging violations of certain sections of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended. Copies of the complaints were forwarded at that time. On July 28, 2022, the Commission decided to exercise its prosecutorial discretion and dismiss the allegations that you violated 52 U.S.C § 30122 by making contributions in the name of another, dismiss the allegations that you violated 52 U.S.C § 30116(a)(1) by making excessive contributions, and dismiss the allegations that you violated 52 U.S.C § 30121(a) and 11 C.F.R. § 110.20(h)(1) by providing substantial assistance in the making of foreign national contributions. The Commission has closed the files. A Statement of Reasons providing a basis for the Commission's decision will follow.

Documents related to the case will be placed on the public record within 30 days. *See Disclosure of Certain Documents in Enforcement and Other Matters*, 81 Fed. Reg. 50,702 (Aug. 2, 2016).
