On April 3, 2019, your clients were notified that the Federal Election Commission received a complaint alleging violation of certain sections of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended. At that time they were given a copy of the complaint and informed that a response to the complaint should be submitted within 15 days of receipt of the notification.
