Dear Mr. Jordan:

We represent David Trahan in Federal Election Commission Matters Under Review 7585 and 7588. We write in response to the Supplemental Complaint in Matter Under Review 7588 filed by the Campaign Legal Center, dated January 16, 2020.

Mr. Trahan supports and incorporates by reference the response to the Supplemental Complaint submitted to the Federal Election Commission (the "Commission") on behalf of Lori Trahan, the Lori Trahan for Congress Committee, and Martha Howe in her official capacity as Treasurer on March 13, 2020 (the "Response"). We agree with the factual representations and the legal arguments outlined in the Response. For the reasons explained therein, the funds Representative Trahan used to make loans to her 2018 campaign were her personal funds under the Commission's regulations, despite Complainant's specious claims to the contrary. Mr. Trahan therefore did not make excessive contributions to Representative Trahan's campaign or otherwise violate the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended, or Commission regulations.

We join the Response in urging the Commission to dismiss this matter and close the file.
