On April 18, 2019, the Federal Election Commission ("Commission") notified your clients, Johnson for Congress and Paul Kilgore as treasurer, Ted Yoho for Congress and Laura Jackson as treasurer, Yvette4Congress, and Philip Pearce as treasurer, Pete Stauber for Congress Volunteer Committee and Sandra Finch as treasurer, Coffman for Congress 2018 and Jacque Ponder as treasurer, Emmer for Congress and Paul Kilgore as treasurer, and Anthony Gonzalez for Congress and Natalie Bauer as treasurer, of a complaint alleging violations of certain sections of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended (the "Act").

On July 2, 2020, based upon the information contained in the complaint and information provided by respondents, the Commission found no reason to believe that your clients violated 52 U.S.C. § 30121(a)(2). Accordingly, the Commission closed its file in this matter.
