On April 18, 2019, the Federal Election Commission ("Commission") notified your client, Chafin for Senate Campaign, of a complaint alleging violations of certain sections of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended (the "Act").

On July 2, 2020, based upon the information contained in the complaint and information provided by respondents, the Commission found no reason to believe that your client violated 52 U.S.C.§ 30121(a)(2). Accordingly, the Commission closed its file in this matter.
