GENERAL COUNSEL'S REPORT

I. Allegation

In a complaint filed with the Commission (letter of January 7, 1976, notarized complaint of January 26, 1976), Edward P. Beard, Member of Congress, alleged that (1) Martin T. Byrne (candidate) violated 18 U.S.C. §610 (now 2 U.S.C. §441b) by using labor union personnel, equipment and facilities for campaign purposes; (2) James J. Downey violated §610 by making use of corporate stationery to aid the Byrne campaign and (3) that a ticket to a Byrne campaign event failed to have a "disclaimer."

II. Evidence

Enclosed with the complaint was a copy of a ticket to "Unity Night" for Martin Byrne. Also enclosed was a letter dated October 24, 1975 by James J. Downey, Jr., apparently on stationery of the New England Labor Consultants, Inc., urging persons to attend a meeting to discuss a draft movement for Mr. Byrne.

Initially, both Mr. Byrne and Mr. Downey engaged the same counsel, who by letter dated February 10, 1976, entered a general denial of complainant's allegations. Subsequently, each employed separate counsel. By letter through counsel dated March 11, 1976, Martin T. Byrne denied the allegation of use of union personnel, etc., for campaign purposes. He further maintained that the tickets to the fundraiser were printed and distributed by an enthusiastic volunteer without the knowledge of or authorization by Mr. Byrne, but failed to identify the volunteer.

By letter dated April 19, 1976, an appearance was entered on behalf of James J. Downey, by separate counsel. Mr. Downey has made no further response to the allegations against him.

III. Analysis and Recommendations

(1) The complainant has submitted no factual substantiation for his allegation that Mr. Byrne used labor union personnel, equipment and facilities for campaign purposes. This allegation should be dismissed.

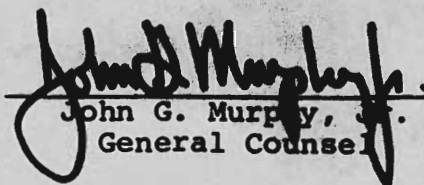
(2) In the absence of a response from Mr. Downey the use of the stationery of the New England Labor Consultants, Inc., to solicit participation in a campaign strategy meeting suggests a possible violation of 18 U.S.C. §610 (now 2 U.S.C. §441b). A further inquiry should be made to Mr. Downey's counsel.

(3) There is no legal requirement for a "disclaimer" on a ticket such as the one in question. This allegation should be dismissed.

The letter of complaint in its second paragraph, first sentence, makes too general a complaint for me to respond to intelligently. I cannot refute such language as "is using union personnel, equipment and facilities for campaign purposes" except with a general denial.

In the event that the complainant will furnish under oath more precise dates, times, which personnel, what equipment and facilities were being used, then I will be able to respond to each allegation.

The letter of complaint in its first paragraph, second and third sentences, makes reference to tickets and "lack of a disclaimer". The only section of the law which appears to mention a disclaimer is §432 (e) which is clearly inapplicable in this situation.

The F.E.C. letter refers to 2 U.S.C. §435 (b), which section is entitled "Requirements relating to campaign advertising"; and by its language does not apply to a ticket for an event.

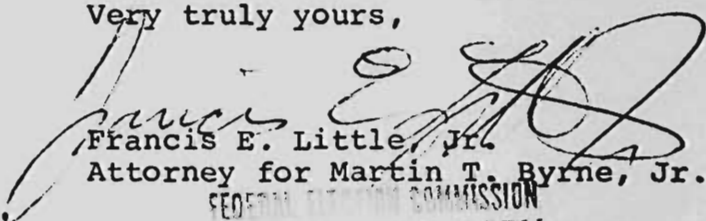
A brief history may be helpful as to the resolution of this problem of the tickets.

My client has never been a candidate for elective office before and there was a draft movement among his friends which started with the letter of October 24, 1975 sent by James J. Downey, Jr., a copy of his letter being attached to the letter of complaint. Sometime thereabout tickets were printed and distributed by an enthusiastic volunteer without the knowledge of or authorization by my client.

In the event that the Commission wishes to pursue this matter further, I will furnish the name and address of the volunteer.

I trust this response has been satisfactory and I will await your further advice in this matter.

This letter is in reference to F.E.C. letter dated January 23, 1976, from Gordon A. McKay, in which he states that Edward P. Beard, incumbent in the 2nd Congressional District of Rhode Island, filed a complaint against my client, Martin T. Byrne, Jr., who is presently a declared candidate for the complainant's seat.

At this time, I wish to thank the Committee for its kindness in extending my time for responding as per your letter of February 24, 1976.

First an observation as to the letter from the complainant sent on Congressional stationery dated January 7, 1976. It is my understanding that the F.E.C. "Interim Guideline: Complaint Procedure" requires that "the complaint must be verified by oath or affirmation of such person (complainant). The letter of January 7, 1976, that was sent to my client does not contain such requirement. It would appear that my client should have a copy of the complaint containing an oath or affirmation, prior to making any response which requires that he, in his response, have his signature verified by oath or affirmation. However, in the interest of a speedy resolution of this matter, but reserving all of my client's rights under the rules of F.E.C., I shall respond to the said letter of complaint.

The letter of complaint states in its first paragraph that my client "intends to run against me for Congress". The fact is that my client, as of January 7, 1976, had not formally announced as a candidate and had made it plain that he would not make up his mind until the night of January 16, 1976.

This letter is in reference to F.E.C. letter dated January 23, 1976, from Gordon A. McKay, in which he states that Edward P. Beard, incumbent in the 2nd Congressional District of Rhode Island, filed a complaint against my client, Martin T. Byrne, Jr., who is presently a declared candidate for the complainant's seat.

At this time, I wish to thank the Committee for its kindness in extending my time for responding as per your letter of February 24, 1976.

First an observation as to the letter from the complainant sent on Congressional stationery dated January 7, 1976. It is my understanding that the F.E.C. "Interim Guideline: Complaint Procedure" requires that "the complaint must be verified by oath or affirmation of such person (complainant). The letter of January 7, 1976, that was sent to my client does not contain such requirement. It would appear that my client should have a copy of the complaint containing an oath or affirmation, prior to making any response which requires that he, in his response, have his signature verified by oath or affirmation. However, in the interest of a speedy resolution of this matter, but reserving all of my client's rights under the rules of F.E.C., I shall respond to the said letter of complaint.

The letter of complaint states in its first paragraph that my client "intends to run against me for Congress". The fact is that my client, as of January 7, 1976, had not formally announced as a candidate and had made it plain that he would not make up his mind until the night of January 16, 1976.

The letter of complaint in its second paragraph, first sentence, makes too general a complaint for me to respond to intelligently. I cannot refute such language as "is using union personnel, equipment and facilities for campaign purposes" except with a general denial.

In the event that the complainant will furnish under oath more precise dates, times, which personnel, what equipment and facilities were being used, then I will be able to respond to each allegation.

The letter of complaint in its first paragraph, second and third sentences, makes reference to tickets and "lack of a disclaimer". The only section of the law which appears to mention a disclaimer is §432 (e) which is clearly inapplicable in this situation.

The F.E.C. letter refers to 2 U.S.C. §435 (b), which section is entitled "Requirements relating to campaign advertising"; and by its language does not apply to a ticket for an event.

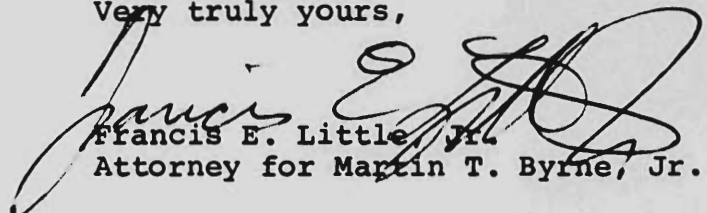
A brief history may be helpful as to the resolution of this problem of the tickets.

I. Allegation

In a complaint filed with the Commission (letter of January 7, 1976, notarized complaint of January 26, 1976), Edward P. Beard, Member of Congress, alleged that (1) Martin T. Byrne (candidate) violated 18 U.S.C. §610 by using labor union personnel, equipment and facilities for campaign purposes; (2) James J. Downey violated §610 by making use of corporate stationery to aid the Byrne campaign and (3) that a ticket to a Byrne campaign event failed to have a "disclaimer".

II. Evidence

Two pieces of evidence, enclosed with the complainant are attached. One is a copy of a ticket to "Unity Night" for Martin Byrne. The other is a letter dated October 24, 1975 by James J. Downey, Jr. urging persons to attend a meeting to discuss a draft movement for Mr. Byrne.

Candidate Byrne responded to the complaint by denying any illegality and asking for more specifics from Congressman Beard. James J. Downey, Jr. has not responded to the complaint.

III. Analysis

We do not have the necessary facts to analyze allegation (1).

Concerning allegation (2), several key facts are unknown James J. Downey, Jr. did send a letter on corporate stationery seeking support for a candidate for Congress. The first question which must be answered is: Is new England Labor Consultants, Inc., actually a corporation? Secondly, who was the letter sent to? If the letter only went to stockholders and employees there is no §610 violation because of SUN PAC AO 1975-23.

Concerning allegation (3), there is no "disclaimer" provision in the Federal Election Campaign Act. The §435(b) notice provision does not apply to tickets to a fundraising event but to campaign advertisements soliciting contributions.

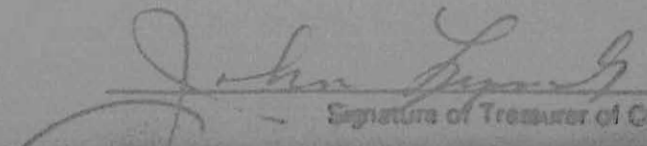
