Dear Mr. Price:

On May 8, 2019 and August 7, 2020, the Federal Election Commission ("Commission") notified you of a complaint, and supplemental complaint alleging that you had violated certain sections of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended.

On September 14, 2021, the Commission considered the complaint and supplemental allegations, and responses but was evenly split as to whether to find reason to believe or to dismiss the complaint allegations. Accordingly, the Commission closed its file in this matter.

Documents related to the case will be placed on the public record within 30 days. *See* Disclosure of Certain Documents in Enforcement and Other Matters, 81 Fed. Reg. 50,702 (Aug. 2, 2016), effective September 1, 2016. One or more Statements of Reason explaining the Commission's decision will follow.
