Dear Mr. Clayton:

On May 10, 2019 and August 7, 2020, the Federal Election Commission ("Commission") notified you, in your official capacity as treasurer of the terminated committee, Judson Hill for Congress ("Committee"), of a complaint and supplemental complaint alleging that the Committee and you, in your official capacity as treasurer, had violated certain sections of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended.

On September 14, 2021, the Commission considered the complaint and supplemental allegations, and responses but was there were insufficient votes to dismiss the allegations that the Committee and you in your official capacity as treasurer violated 52 U.S.C.§§ 30116(a) and 30122. Accordingly, the Commission closed its file in this matter.

Documents related to the case will be placed on the public record within 30 days. *See* Disclosure of Certain Documents in Enforcement and Other Matters, 81 Fed. Reg. 50,702 (Aug. 2, 2016), effective September 1, 2016. One or more Statements of Reason explaining the Commission's decision will follow.
