On May 24, 2019, the Federal Election Commission notified your client, America First Action, Inc., and Jon Proch in his official capacity as Treasurer, of a complaint alleging violations of certain sections of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended. On April 6, 2022, the Commission voted to take no further action regarding the allegations that your client violated 52 U.S.C. § 30121(a)(2) by knowingly soliciting and accepting prohibited foreign national contributions. Accordingly, on April 6, 2022, the Commission closed the file in this matter.

Documents related to the case will be placed on the public record within 30 days. *See* Disclosure of Certain Documents in Enforcement and Other Matters, 81 Fed. Reg. 50,702 (Aug. 2, 2016).
