Dear Mr. Crosland:

On May 30, 2019, the Federal Election Commission ("Commission") notified your clients, Trump Victory and Bradley T. Crate in his official capacity as treasurer and Make America Great Again PAC f/k/a Donald J. Trump for President, Inc. and Bradley T. Crate in his official capacity as treasurer, of a complaint alleging violations of certain sections of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended. A copy of the complaint was forwarded to your clients at that time. On July 28, 2022, the Commission decided to exercise its prosecutorial discretion and dismiss the allegations that your clients violated 52 U.S.C. § 30121 by accepting foreign national contributions. The Commission has closed the file. A Statement of Reasons which more fully explains the basis for the Commission's decisions will follow.

Documents related to the case will be placed on the public record within 30 days. *See* Disclosure of Certain Documents in Enforcement and Other Matters, 81 Fed. Reg. 50,702 (Aug. 2, 2016).
