GENERAL COUNSEL'S REPORT

Allegations

Two candidates and one committee supporting a candidate for the U.S. House of Representatives from the state of Louisiana were published by the Press Office and referred to the Office of General Counsel from the Reports Analysis Division for failing to file the 10 day pre-election report for the Louisiana primary election held on September 16, 1978.

Evidence

(1) William King

William King, a candidate from the 2nd District of Louisiana has filed no reports with the Commission. The Commission found reason to believe on September 8, 1978; and reasonable cause to believe on September 11, 1978, that Mr. King was in violation of 2 U.S.C. §434 for failing to file a 10 day pre-election report for the primary election. We have not been able to contact Mr. King through the mail or by telephone.

Mr. King was defeated in the primary election although he received 6.3% (3,993) of the vote. In accordance with the Commission's non-filing procedures, we recommend that no further action be taken against William King at this time.

(2) Bobby Gene Paillette, Sr.

Bobby Gene Paillette, Sr., a Democratic candidate from the 6th District of Louisiana began filing reports with the Commission in April, 1977. The Commission found reason to believe on September 8, 1978; and reasonable cause to believe on September 11, 1978, that Mr. Paillette was in violation of 2 U.S.C. §434 for failing to file a 10 day pre-election report for the primary election.

Mr. Paillette has filed 3a postcards since the inception of his candidacy revealing no specific receipts or expenditures. He also filed a statement of candidacy on September 11, 1978, on which he waived his responsibility to file reports. He was defeated in the election although he received 9% (10,050) of the vote. In accordance with the Commission's non-filing procedures, we recommend that no further action should be taken against Bobby Gene Paillette at this time.

(3) Democrats for Bobby Paillette Committee Bobby Gene Paillette's principal campaign committee, the Democrats for Bobby Paillette Committee, began filing reports with the Commission in April 1977. The Commission found reason to believe on September 8, 1978; and reasonable cause to believe on September 11, 1978, that the Democrats for Bobby Paillette Committee was in violation of 2 U.S.C. §434 for failing to file a 10 day pre-election report for the primary election.

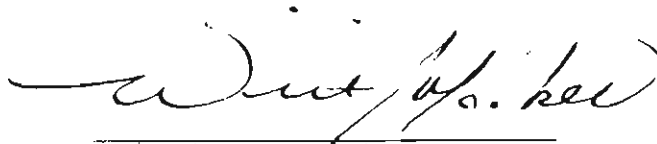
The Democrats for Bobby Paillette Committee have reported a total of \$514 in receipts and \$500 in expenditures in their previous reports. Bobby Gene Paillette lost the election with 9% (10,050 votes) of the vote. In accordance with the Commission's non-filing procedures,

we recommend no further action be taken against the Democrats for Bobby Paillette Committee.

Recommendation

Take no further action at this time against William King, Bobby Gene Paillette, Sr., or the Democrats for Bobby Paillette Committee in connection with failure to file a 10 day pre-election report in violation of 2 U.S.C. §434. Close the file.

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Senate Primary:

Johnston Wins New Term In Louisiana Primary

Democratic Sen. J. Bennett Johnston assured himself of a second Senate term by defeating his one challenger in the Sept. 16 primary in Louisiana.

Under the state's new primary system, Johnston will appear on the Nov. 7 general election ballot unopposed. In the Louisiana non-partisan primary, candidates of all parties run against each other. If a candidate receives more than 50 percent of the primary vote, as Johnston did, he runs in November without any opposition. If no one receives more than 50 percent, the top two finishers, regardless of party, face each other in November.

Johnston carried all but four of the state's 64 parishes against Democratic state Rep. Louis "Woody" Jenkins, who mounted a conservative challenge to Johnston. John-

ston defeated Jenkins in the parish around Jenkins' home of Baton Rouge by a vote of about 33,000 to 25,400.

The incumbent also won in New Orleans by a 2-1 margin, and carried the neighboring parish of Jefferson, which contains New Orleans suburbs, by nearly as large a margin. But Jenkins did draw a sizable minority of the vote in many areas of the state, indicating some discontent with the conservative but low-key incumbent.

All House members seeking re-election, including first-term Republican Robert Livingston and first-term Democrat Jerry Huckaby, were guaranteed re-election by winning more than 50 percent of the primary vote. Only one runoff will be held in the state in November — for the 4th District seat of retiring Democratic Rep. Joe D. Waggoner Jr.

The two competitors in the 4th District are Democratic state Rep. Claude "Buddy" Leach of Leesville and former state Rep. Jimmy Wilson of Vivian, a Republican who quit the Democratic State Committee this year.

Finishing a close third behind Leach and Wilson in the nine-person field was Charles E. Roemer III, who failed to make the runoff despite spending about \$400,000.

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Senate Primary:

Johnston Wins New Term In Louisiana Primary

Democratic Sen. J. Bennett Johnston assured himself of a second Senate term by defeating his one challenger in the Sept. 16 primary in Louisiana.

Under the state's new primary system, Johnston will appear on the Nov. 7 general election ballot unopposed. In the Louisiana non-partisan primary, candidates of all parties run against each other. If a candidate receives more than 50 percent of the primary vote, as Johnston did, he runs in November without any opposition. If no one receives more than 50 percent, the top two finishers, regardless of party, face each other in November.

Johnston carried all but four of the state's 64 parishes against Democratic state Rep. Louis "Woody" Jenkins, who mounted a conservative challenge to Johnston. John-

ston defeated Jenkins in the parish around Jenkins' home of Baton Rouge by a vote of about 33,000 to 25,400.

The incumbent also won in New Orleans by a 2-1 margin, and carried the neighboring parish of Jefferson, which contains New Orleans suburbs, by nearly as large a margin. But Jenkins did draw a sizable minority of the vote in many areas of the state, indicating some discontent with the conservative but low-key incumbent.

All House members seeking re-election, including first-term Republican Robert Livingston and first-term Democrat Jerry Huckaby, were guaranteed re-election by winning more than 50 percent of the primary vote. Only one runoff will be held in the state in November — for the 4th District seat of retiring Democratic Rep. Joe D. Waggoner Jr.

The two competitors in the 4th District are Democratic state Rep. Claude "Buddy" Leach of Leesville and former state Rep. Jimmy Wilson of Vivian, a Republican who quit the Democratic State Committee this year.

Finishing a close third behind Leach and Wilson in the nine-person field was Charles E. Roemer III, who failed to make the runoff despite spending about \$400,000.
