Dear Mr. Gober:

On July 11, 2019, and November 1, 2019, respectively, the Federal Election Commission ("Commission") notified your clients, Matt Rosendale for Montana and Errol Galt in his official capacity as treasurer, of complaints alleging violations of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended (the "Act"). A copy of each complaint was forwarded to your clients at that time.

The Commission considered the complaint but was equally divided on whether to find reason to believe that your clients violated 52 U.S.C. §§ 30104(b), 30116(f), and 30118(a), provisions of the Act. Accordingly, on September 6, 2022, the Commission closed its files in these matters.

Documents related to the case will be placed on the public record within 30 days. *See Disclosure of Certain Documents in Enforcement and Other Matters*, 81 Fed. Reg. 50,702 (Aug. 2, 2016). A Statement of Reasons explaining the Commission's decision is attached.
