

)**THIRD CONSENT TO EXTEND THE TIME TO COMMENCE A CIVIL LAW
ENFORCEMENT ACTION, SUIT, OR PROCEEDING**

Respondent, Alter City Group Holdings Limited, hereby consents to toll the statute of limitations for any civil action, suit, or proceeding that the Federal Election Commission might institute in connection with MUR 7624 pursuant to 52 U.S.C. § 30109(a) for the time period during which the Commission lacks a quorum of at least four commissioners.

This agreement will extend the time to institute a civil law enforcement suit from the expiration date of the five-year statute of limitations found at 28 U.S.C. § 2462 or any other statute of limitations or repose that may be applicable in this matter. This Consent supplements the Consent to Extend the Time to Commence a Civil Law Enforcement Action, Suit, or Proceeding signed by Robert Tenorio Torres on September 9, 2019, and the Second Consent to Extend the Time to Commence a Civil Law Enforcement Action, Suit, or Proceeding signed by Robert Tenorio Torres on January 17, 2020.

There shall be no additional consent to extend the time to institute a civil law enforcement suit without the written consent of the Respondent.
