**SECOND CONSENT TO EXTEND THE TIME TO COMMENCE A CIVIL
LAW ENFORCEMENT ACTION, SUIT, OR PROCEEDING**

Respondent, Imperial Pacific International (CNMI) LLC, hereby consents to toll the statute of limitations for any civil enforcement action, suit, or proceeding that the Federal Election Commission might institute in connection with MUR 7624 pursuant to 52 U.S.C. § 30109(a) for an additional 30 (30) days.

This agreement will extend the time to institute a civil law enforcement action, suit, or proceeding that the Federal Election Commission might institute in connection with MUR 7624 for an additional thirty (30) calendar days from the expiration date of the five-year statute of limitations found at 28 U.S.C. § 2462 or any other statute of limitations or repose that may be applicable in this matter. This Consent supplements the Consent to Extend the Time to Commence a Civil Law Enforcement Action, Suit, or Proceeding dated July 6, 2018. There shall be no additional consent to extend the time to institute a civil law enforcement suit without the written consent of the Respondent.
