On August 1, 2019, you were notified that the Federal Election Commission found reason to believe that Hong Kong Entertainment violated 52 U.S.C. § 30121(a)(1)(A), a provision of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended (the “Act”). After considering the circumstances of the matter, the Commission determined on August 27, 2024, to take no further action as to Hong Kong Entertainment, and voted to close the file in this matter effective October 3, 2024. Any applicable Statements of Reasons available at the time of this letter’s transmittal are enclosed.
