On August 1, 2019, your client, Imperial Pacific International (CNMI) LLC, was notified that the Federal Election Commission found reason to believe that it violated 52 U.S.C. § 30121(a)(1)(A), a provision of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended (the “Act”). On October 23, 2020, your client submitted a response to the Commission’s reason to believe finding. After considering the circumstances of the matter, the Commission determined on August 27, 2024, to take no further action as to Imperial Pacific International (CNMI) LLC and voted to close the file in this matter effective October 3, 2024. Any applicable Statements of Reasons available at the time of this letter’s transmittal are enclosed.
