Dear Mr. Langdon:

On August 9, 2019, and on August 12, 2019, the Federal Election Commission notified your clients, Susan B. Anthony List Inc. Candidate Fund and Jennifer Gross in her capacity as treasurer ("Committee") and The Lukens Company, and Robert J. Kania, II, respectively, of a complaint alleging violations of certain sections of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended ("the Act"). A copy of the complaint was forwarded to your clients at those times.

Upon further review of the allegations contained in the complaint, and information supplied by your clients, the Commission, on November 9, 2021, voted to dismiss the allegation that the Committee violated 52 U.S.C. § 30104(b) and 52 U.S.C. § 30118(a), dismiss the allegation that The Lukens Company violated 52 U.S.C. § 30118, and to find no reason to believe that Robert J. Kania, II, violated the Act, and closed the file in this matter. One or more Statements of Reasons explaining the Commission's decisions may follow.

Documents related to the case will be placed on the public record within 30 days. *See* Disclosure of Certain Documents in Enforcement and Other Matters, 81 Fed. Reg. 50,702 (Aug. 2, 2016).
