On August 14, 2019, the Federal Election Commission notified your client, Joaquin Castro, of a complaint alleging violations of certain sections of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended.

On November 9, 2021, the Commission found, on the basis of the complaint, and information provided by your client, that there is no reason to believe that Joaquin Castro violated 52 U.S.C. § 30111(a)(4) and 11 C.F.R. § 104.15(a). Accordingly, on November 9, 2021, the Commission closed the file in this matter.
