Dear Mr. Reiff and Mr. Mitrani:

On August 28, 2019, the Federal Election Commission received a complaint alleging that your clients Ilhan for Congress and Kate Wittenstein, in her official capacity as treasurer, Representative Ilhan Omar, E Street Group, LLC, and Tim Mynett violated the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended. A copy of the complaint was forwarded to your clients following its receipt. On December 12, 2019, we received your most recent response to the complaint, and the matter is currently under review by the Commission. This letter is to advise you that we expect the Commission to vote on this matter within six months. After the Commission votes, you will receive notification of the Commission's determination.

This matter will remain confidential in accordance with 52 U.S.C. §§ 30109(a)(4)(B) and 30109(a)(12)(A) unless you notify the Commission in writing that you wish the matter to be made public. Please note that your clients have a legal obligation to preserve all documents, records, and materials relating to this matter until such time as they are notified that the Commission has closed its file in this matter. *See* 18 U.S.C. § 1519.
