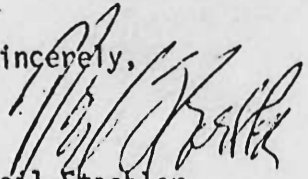

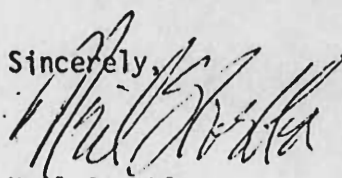

Gubernatorial Primary:

Three-Time Loser Mecham Nominated By Arizona GOP

Veteran Republican office-seeker Evan Mecham scored a surprise victory in Arizona's Sept. 12 Republican gubernatorial primary, defeating wealthy Phoenix insurance executive Jack Londen. In the general election Mecham will face Gov. Bruce E. Babbitt, a landslide winner in the Democratic primary. (*Arizona primary outlook, Weekly Report* p. 2272)

Mecham won by amassing a 14,000-vote lead in populous Maricopa County (Phoenix), which offset Londen's lead in the rest of the state. A political newcomer, Londen had spent \$300,000 in a lavish campaign of media and billboards. Nearly all of the money came out of his own pocket.

Mecham spent only one-third as much and was less visible. But he began the campaign with an edge in name familiarity gained from three earlier tries for statewide office. Two were unsuccessful campaigns for the Republican gubernatorial nomination (1964 and 1974), and one was for the U.S. Senate in 1962.

Most party leaders were unenthusiastic about their choices and remained neutral. But many expressed private doubts about Londen, who was dogged by recurring discussion of business deals in his past.

The deals were prominently questioned in a statewide newspaper, the *Arizona Republic*, on the weekend before the primary. The paper also ran a critical editorial that implied Londen was unfit to be governor.

House

In House contests, Arizona's two freshmen members — Democrat Bob Stump from the 3rd District and Republican Eldon Rudd from the 4th — had no trouble turning back primary challenges.

Stump has so far drawn no Republican opponent in the general election. The lone candidate in the Republican primary withdrew, but the party is allowed to fill the vacancy.

Rudd will face Michael L. McCormick, an upset winner in the Democratic primary. A state party committee member, McCormick surprised well-financed Phoenix lawyer Les Miller, who outspent McCormick by a margin of nearly 10-1. McCormick had no radio or television advertising and only one district-wide newspaper ad. But he has been active in party affairs and had been quietly campaigning in the rural areas of the mammoth district.

McCormick ran as the most conservative candidate in the Democratic field and won applause for his claim that there were too many lawyers in Congress. This is his first race for public office.

Arizona's two veteran House members — Republican Minority Leader John J. Rhodes and Democrat Morris K. Udall — did not have primary opposition.
