On September 4, 2019, the Federal Election Commission notified you of a complaint alleging violations of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended. Upon further review of the allegations contained in the complaint and information you provided, the Commission, on December 2, 2021, found no reason to believe that you are about to violate 52 U.S.C. § 30114(b) and 11 C.F.R. § 113.1(g)(3). Accordingly, the Commission closed its file in this matter.
