On September 4, 2019, the Federal Election Commission notified Friends of Christine O'Donnell and you in your official capacity as treasurer (the "Committee") of a complaint alleging violations of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended. Upon further review of the allegations contained in the complaint and information provided by the Committee, the Commission, on December 2, 2021, found no reason to believe that the Committee is about to violate 52 U.S.C. § 30114(b) and 11 C.F.R. § 113.1(g)(3). Accordingly, the Commission closed its file in this matter.

Documents related to the case will be placed on the public record within 30 days. *See* Disclosure of Certain Documents in Enforcement and Other Matters, 81 Fed. Reg. 50,702 (Aug. 2, 2016). A Statement of Reasons explaining the basis for the Commission's decision will follow.
