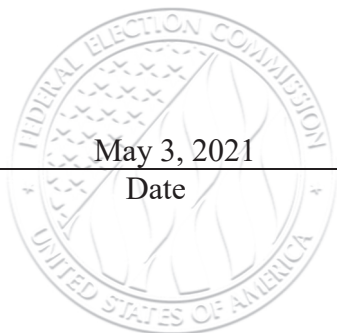

3. Approve the Factual and Legal Analysis, as recommended in the First General Counsel's Report dated January 27, 2020, subject to the edits last circulated by Commissioner Weintraub's Office on April 19, 2021 at 9:04 a.m.
4. Approve the appropriate letters.
5. Close the file as to all Respondents.
