Dear Mary deBeau,

On Tuesday, September 3 I spoke with Dorothy Yeager regarding how to file a complaint concerning a fraudulent campaign contribution attempt initiated by President Donald Trump's Campaign. Then I received a response letter from Mary deBeau, Paralegal Specialist, Complaints Examination & legal Administration dated Sept. 18, which I received on Sept. 21 that it wasn't a "legally-sufficient complaint". 



Dear Ms. Melton:

This is to acknowledge receipt of your letter on September 16, 2019, regarding possible violations of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended (the "Act"). The Act and Commission Regulations require that the contents of a complaint meet certain specific requirements. Your letter does not meet these requirements. Specifically, your letter was not sworn to sufficiently, as required under the Act, nor did your letter include a clear recitation of facts describing violations of the Act over which the Commission has jurisdiction. Consequently, the Commission can take no action at this time unless the allegations are refiled meeting the requirements for a properly filed complaint.

In order to file a legally-sufficient complaint, the complaint must be signed, and its contents sworn to, by the individual filing the complaint in the presence of a notary public. See 52 U.S.C. § 30109(a)(1). The preferred form is "**Subscribed and sworn to before me on this ____ day of ____, 201__.**" It is not sufficient for the notary to acknowledge the identity of the individual before him or her. In addition, a formal complaint should contain a clear and concise recitation of the facts describing the violation of a statute or law over which the Commission has jurisdiction (11 C.F.R. § 111.4).

Please note that this matter will remain confidential for a 15 day period to allow you to correct the defects in your complaint. If the complaint is corrected and refiled within the 15 day period, the respondents will be so informed and provided a copy of the corrected complaint. The respondents will then have an additional 15 days to respond to the complaint on the merits. If the complaint is not corrected, the file will be closed and no additional notification will be provided to the respondents.






