Dear Mr. Najvar:

On October 7 and 30, 2019, the Federal Election Commission notified your client, Troy Nehls, of a complaint and supplemental complaint filed in MUR 7648, and on October 17, 2019, notified your client of a complaint filed in MUR 7651 alleging violations of certain sections of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended (the "Act"). On October 28, 2021, the Commission voted to dismiss the allegations that your client violated the Act. Accordingly, on October 28, 2021, the Commission closed its file in this matter.

Documents related to the case will be placed on the public record within 30 days. *See Disclosure of Certain Documents in Enforcement and Other Matters*, 81 Fed. Reg. 50,702 (Aug. 2, 2016). One or more Statements of Reasons explaining the Commission's decision may follow.
