The Federal Election Commission has considered the allegations contained in your complaint dated October 16, 2019 but was equally divided on whether to find reason to believe that Robert Rodden, Nicole Rodden, and Nicole Rodden for Congress, Inc. and Paul Kilgore in his official capacity as treasurer violated the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended. Accordingly, on October 14, 2021, the Commission closed the file in this matter. A Statement of Reasons providing a basis for the Commission's decision will follow.

Documents related to the case will be placed on the public record within 30 days. *See Disclosure of Certain Documents in Enforcement and Other Matters*, 81 Fed. Reg. 50,702 (Aug. 2, 2016), effective September 1, 2016.
