Dear Mr. Chalmers:

On October 17, 2019, the Federal Election Commission notified your clients, Robert Rodden, Nicole Rodden, and Nicole Rodden for Congress, Inc. and Paul Kilgore in his official capacity as treasurer of a complaint alleging that they had violated certain sections of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended (the “Act”). On October 13-14, 2021, the Commission considered the complaint but was equally divided on whether to find reason to believe that your clients violated the Act. Accordingly, the Commission closed its file in this matter. A Statement of Reasons providing a basis for the Commission’s decision will follow.

Documents related to the case will be placed on the public record within 30 days. *See Disclosure of Certain Documents in Enforcement and Other Matters*, 81 Fed. Reg. 50,702 (Aug. 2, 2016), effective September 1, 2016.
