Dear Mr. Bayes and Ms. Johnson:

On November 13, 2019, the Federal Election Commission (“Commission”) notified your clients, Cory Gardner for Senate and Lisa Lisker in her official capacity as treasurer of a complaint alleging violations of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended (the “Act”). A copy of each complaint was forwarded to your clients at that time.

The Commission considered the complaint but there was an insufficient number of votes to determine whether or not your clients violated 52 U.S.C. §§ 30104(b), 30116(a), and 30118(a), provisions of the Act. Accordingly, on September 6, 2022, the Commission closed its file in this matter.

Documents related to the case will be placed on the public record within 30 days. *See Disclosure of Certain Documents in Enforcement and Other Matters*, 81 Fed. Reg. 50,702 (Aug. 2, 2016). A Statement of Reasons explaining the Commission’s decision is enclosed.
