On December 18, 2019, the Federal Election Commission notified your client, Putnam Partners, LLC, of a complaint alleging violations of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended. A copy of the complaint was forwarded to your client at that time. Upon further review of the allegations contained in the complaint and information supplied by your client, the Commission, on September 28, 2022, voted to dismiss the allegation that Putnam Partners, LLC, violated 52 U.S.C. §§ 30116(a) or 30118(a) by making an excessive or prohibited in-kind contribution.

Documents related to the case will be placed on the public record within 30 days. *See* Disclosure of Certain Documents in Enforcement and Other Matters, 81 Fed. Reg. 50,702 (Aug. 2, 2016). If a Statement of Reasons is issued by one or more Commissioners, it will be provided to you.
