Dear Messrs. Elias and Berkon and Ms. Reulbach:

On December 18, 2019, the Federal Election Commission notified your clients, Hickenlooper 2020 and Blanca Uzeta O'Leary in her official capacity as treasurer and Giddy Up PAC and Stephanie Donner in her official capacity as treasurer, of a complaint alleging violations of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended. A copy of the complaint was forwarded to your clients at that time. Upon further review of the allegations contained in the complaint and information supplied by your clients, the Commission, on September 28, 2022, found no reason to believe that Hickenlooper 2020 and Giddy Up PAC violated the Act in connection with the allegations in this matter.

Documents related to the case will be placed on the public record within 30 days. *See* Disclosure of Certain Documents in Enforcement and Other Matters, 81 Fed. Reg. 50,702 (Aug. 2, 2016). If a Statement of Reasons is issued by one or more Commissioners, it will be provided to you.
