 - b. Approve the Factual and Legal Analysis, as recommended in the First General Counsel's Report dated July 17, 2020, subject to the Office of General Counsel incorporating the edits to the Factual and Legal Analysis circulated by Commissioner Weintraub's Office on January 25, 2021 at 5:50 p.m.
 - c. Authorize the use of compulsory process, as necessary.
 - d. Approve the appropriate letters.

Commissioners Broussard, Walther, and Weintraub voted affirmatively for the motion.

Commissioners Cooksey, Dickerson, and Trainor dissented.

2. Decided by a vote of 6-0 to:

- b.
