In response to the supplement complaint from Major Mike Webb, for case number MUR 7691, NARFE-PAC submits the following:

NARFE-PAC respectfully requests the Federal Election Commission (FEC) dismiss the complaint for failure to allege any violation of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971 by NARFE-PAC.


At worst, the complaint appears to imply that NARFE-PAC's current Statement of Organization is out of date, incomplete or incorrect. It is none of those, and the complaint alleges no facts showing that it is. Even if it did allege such facts, there would be no evidence to support such allegations. Regardless, a mere implication does not constitute an alleged violation.

NARFE-PAC's Statement of Organization on file with the FEC is up-to-date and accurate. The complaint alleges no facts and provides no evidence showing otherwise.

Furthermore, NARFE-PAC is not an affiliated committee/organization (under FEC law) with Respondent Voice of American Federation of Government Employees Super PAC (C00512292) nor the American Federation of Government Employees (AFGE), or any affiliated organizations or committees of AFGE. Given that fact, the complaint alleges nothing indicating that NARFE-PAC is so affiliated.

For these reasons, I respectfully request the FEC dismiss the complaint.
