While preparing the closing letters and reviewing the certification of the vote, the Office 1 of General Counsel noticed an oversight in that we failed to include Respondent Sara Gideon in 2 the recommendations, or the findings as stated in Factual and Legal Analysis. Therefore, we 3 recommend that the Commission reopen the file, find no reason to believe that Sara Gideon 4 violated 52 U.S.C. § 30116(f) and 11 C.F.R. § 110.9 by knowingly accepting an excessive 5 contribution, rescind the Factual and Legal Analysis, and approve the attached revised Factual 6 and Legal Analysis. 7
