MUR 7743 (Beth for Congress) Pre-Probable Cause Conciliation

On May 24, 2022, the Commission found reason to believe that Beth for Congress and Bradley T. Crate in his official capacity as treasurer (the "Committee") violated 52 U.S.C. § 30104(b)(3)(E) and 11 C.F.R. § 104.3(d)(4) by failing to disclose required information about candidate loans. The Commission authorized the Office of the General Counsel to engage in pre-probable cause conciliation with the Committee. Attached is a negotiated conciliation agreement with the Committee, which would resolve the violations. We recommend the Commission accept the signed agreement.
