22 On April 28, 2022, the Commission found reason to believe that Casey Askar for  
23 Congress and Rob Phillips III in his official capacity as treasurer (the "Committee"), violated  
24 52 U.S.C. § 30104(b)(3)(E) and 11 C.F.R. § 104.3(a)(4)(iv), (d)(4) by failing to file complete  
25 and accurate reports.<sup>1</sup> On June 7, 2022, the Commission authorized the Office of the General  
26 Counsel to engage in pre-probable cause conciliation with the Committee.<sup>2</sup>
