This is to advise you that the Federal Election Commission, on November 17, 2022, voted to reject the signed conciliation agreement with Casey Askar for Congress and Rob Phillips III in his official capacity as Treasurer. The Commission further voted to close the file in this matter. The Commission nevertheless hereby admonishes Casey Askar for Congress and Rob Phillips III in his official capacity as Treasurer for an apparent violation of 52 U.S.C. § 30104(b)(3)(E) and 11 C.F.R. § 104.3(a)(4)(iv), (d)(4) by failing to file complete and accurate reports regarding the line of credit from Northern Bank.

Documents related to the case will be placed on the public record within 30 days. *See* Disclosure of Certain Documents in Enforcement and Other Matters, 81 Fed. Reg. 50,702 (Aug. 2, 2016). A Statement of Reasons providing a basis for the Commission's decision is not required in this matter, but if one is issued, it will be provided to you.
