On June 22, 2020, the Federal Election Commission notified your clients, Rev. Rubén Díaz for Congress and Andreina Cruz in her official capacity as treasurer and Rev. Rubén Díaz, Sr., of a complaint alleging violations of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended.

Upon further review of the allegations contained in the complaint, and information provided by your clients, the Commission, on November 9, 2021, voted to dismiss the complaint as to your clients. Accordingly, the Commission closed its file in this matter.
