My response to the amended MUR 7748 is as follows.

From what I can understand as new allegations let me assert that I did not have multiple bank accounts for my campaign. I did not "run transactions on and off the books" or intentionally mislead the FEC in my reporting or lack thereof. I stand by my previous answers and add that the reports filed with the FEC were accurate to the best of my knowledge at the time and that we need to file additional reports for the year 2018, 2019 and now 2020. I also understand my limitations in understanding the FEC reporting system and therefore desire to file amended reports for all quarters previously filed with the FEC. My attempts to find a qualified FEC trained treasurer is proving to be more difficult than I first thought and the person that agreed to take over and re-file and newly file all the quarter reports has had to rescind that offer for reasons outside of this matter. I will be checking with a few more people about recommendations for a treasurer who can take on this responsibility and file the proper paperwork so that our committee is in compliance.
