On June 24, 2020, the Federal Election Commission notified your clients, U.S. Representative Lucy McBath and Friends of Lucy McBath and Kendra-Sue Derby in her official capacity as treasurer, of a complaint alleging that your clients violated certain sections of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended (the "Act").

On August 31, 2021, the Commission considered the complaint but was equally divided on whether to find reason to believe your clients violated the Act. On September 2, 2021, the Commission closed its file in this matter.

Documents related to the case will be placed on the public record within 30 days. *See* Disclosure of Certain Documents in Enforcement and Other Matters, 81 Fed. Reg. 50,702 (Aug. 2, 2016), effective September 1, 2016. A Statement of Reasons explaining the Commission's decision is will follow.]
